Kathleen "Cookie" Briney



Animal Services employees and shelter animals lost a dear friend and advocate on Thursday October 11, 2012 when Kathleen "Cookie" Briney passed away due to cancer. Cookie was 63 years old.

Cookie, as she preferred to be called, first approached Riverside County Animal Services in 2004 and wanted to be a volunteer at what was then the county's desert shelter in Indio. Ms. Briney had just been driving by the Indio shelter one day when she decided to stop in to see how she might be able to assist. She never left!

When Riverside County and desert city partners con-

structed and opened the Coachella Valley Animal Campus in Thousand Palms in 2005, Cookie continued her efforts to be a voice as an employee for the desert's homeless desert pets. She worked as an adoption counselor, an adoptions supervisor and a volunteer services coordinator.

Understanding that not every animal could be saved, Cookie, colleagues say, always treated each pet with dignity and love.

"Cookie was a loyal and dedicated employee of Animal Services and I will always remember Cookie with a puppy in her arms or walking around with a small breed dog at her side," said Rob Miller, Director of Western Riverside County/City Animal Services said. "Cookie was a true champion for rescuing and adopting homeless animals into new loving families. She will be dearly missed by all of us who knew her."
