
HOW TO PROPERLY SCAN AN ANIMAL FOR A MICROCHIP



- 1. Turn on the scanner by pushing the power button on.
- 2. Once on, you may begin scanning.
- 3. Hold the scanner over the surface of the animal at all times when scanning; all scanners should be held in contact with the fur or skin.
- 4. The scanner should be moved in small circular motions over the animal; this action helps maximize the potential for microchip orientation and successful scanning.
- 5. All areas A,B,C, and D need to be scanned due to potential chip migration.
- 6. Scanner will vibrate if a chip is found and it will appear on the screen.
